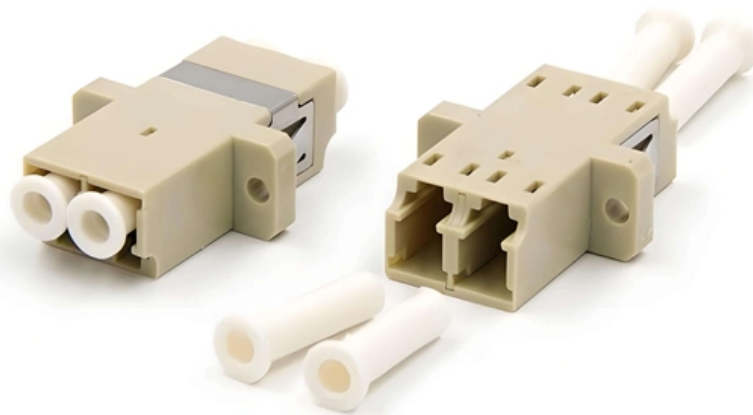


10kV Through-Fiber Cable Distance





Overview

40 km (25 miles): Used for metropolitan area networks (MANs) and often requires signal amplification. 10 GB/S Network – where 1000BASE-SX is insufficient, and you're moving to a 10-gigabit network, you'll need to consider using a higher-grade cable. An OM1 cable would have a distance of just 33 meters on a 10GBASE-SR network, but offers 275 meters for 1000BASE-SX networks. In this blog, I will discuss the fiber optic cable distance, the effect factors, how to choose the right fiber optic cables, and how to compare the transmission distances of single-mode and multimode fiber optic cables.

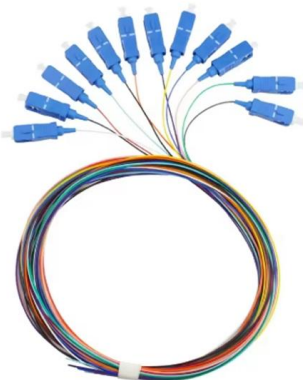

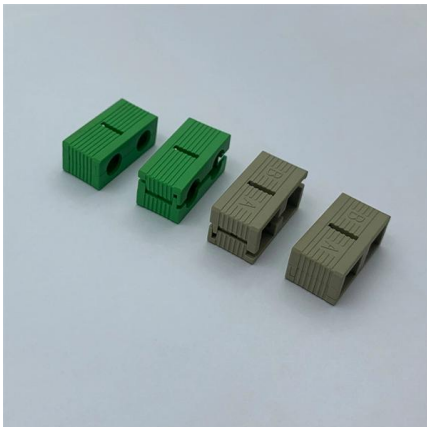
