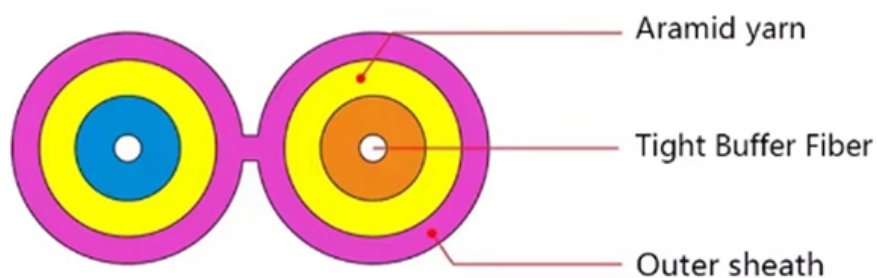


Cascading multiple PoE switches





Overview
