This configuration effectively turns either the cold aisle or the hot aisle into its own room by sealing the aisle with doors, sidewalls, and roofs (as shown in Figures 3



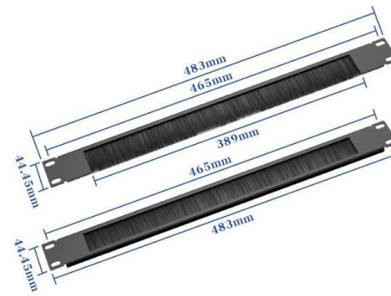
