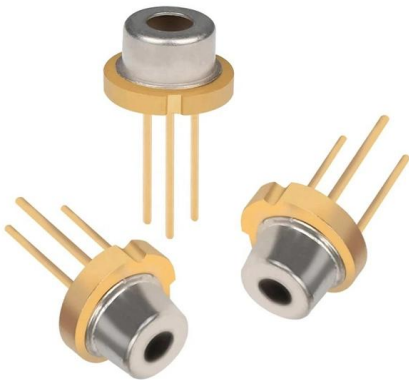
Where should we put fire extinguishers?
