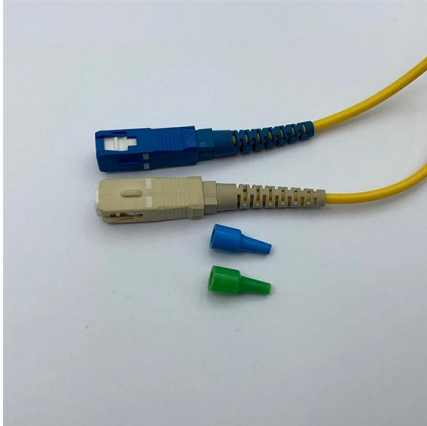


Overview

This post will deal with creating Layer 2 VLANs on Cisco switches and performing all relevant configurations. By default, only VLAN 1 is configured on the switch, so if you connect hosts on an out-of-the-box switch they all belong to. Configuring a switch to support multiple VLANs isolates network traffic, improving security and performance.



Core switch has two VLANs

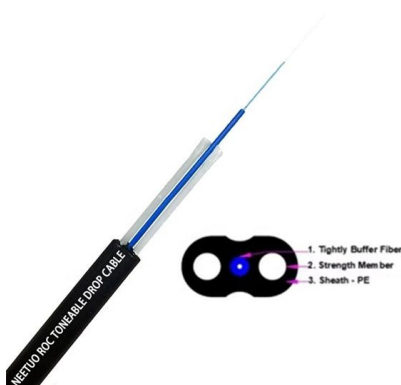

If two VLANs (a VLAN is a layer-2 broadcast domain) could communicate at layer-2, then it would be a single VLAN, not two VLANs. VLANs

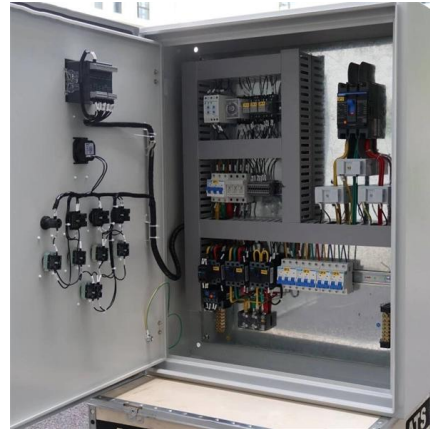


Inter-VLAN Routing: RoAS, SVIs & What Breaks First

A basic VLAN lab needs two switches, one router or L3 switch, and a couple of endpoints. Start with RoAS (it's simpler to set up), then rebuild the same topology using SVIs.

Do I have to configure new VLANs on the core switch?

If your access/distribution switches connect the user vlans to the core using trunks, then you will need to configure the vlans on both the access/distribution and on the core.

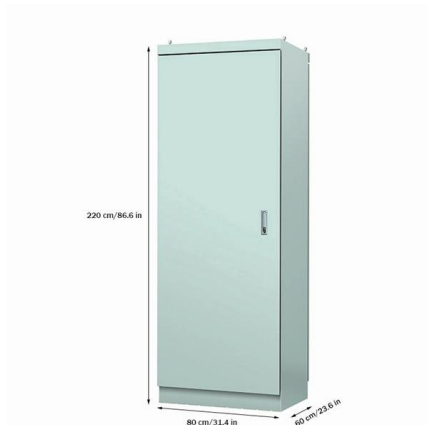

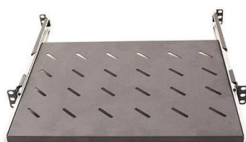

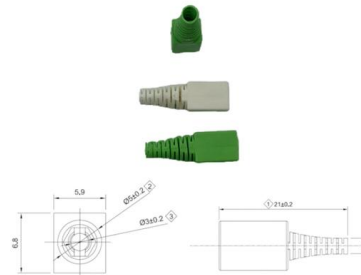
