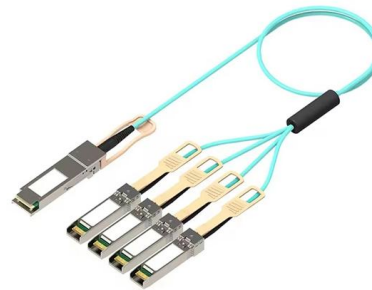

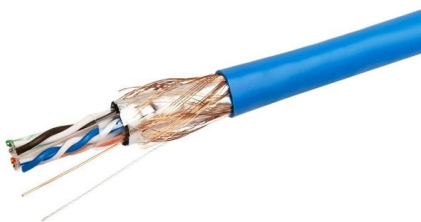
DEW AND FROST DEVELOPMENT

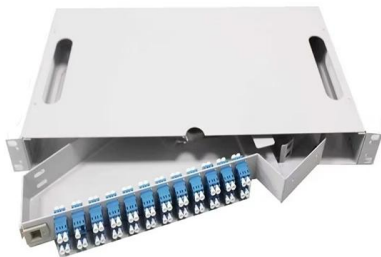

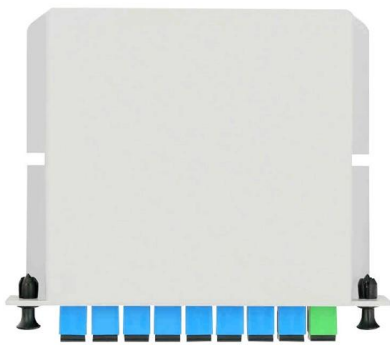
