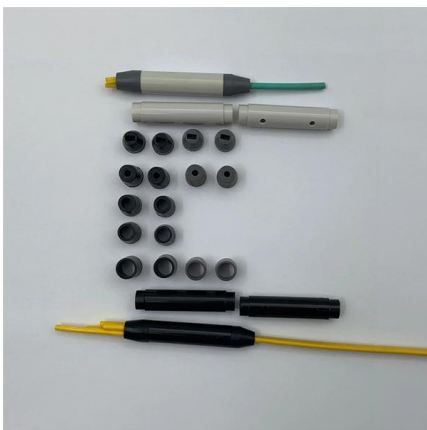

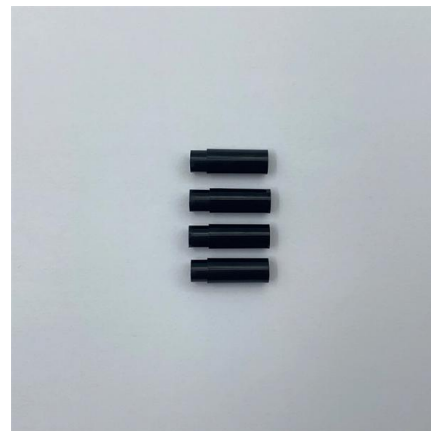

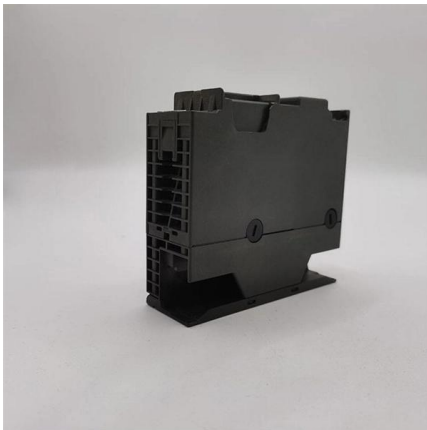
Tray Cable

At the vertical drops, a #3 insulated wire is split bolted onto the #3/0 and run with the tray cable in each separate conduit down to the panel. In the panel: you now have 2x #3 ground wires,

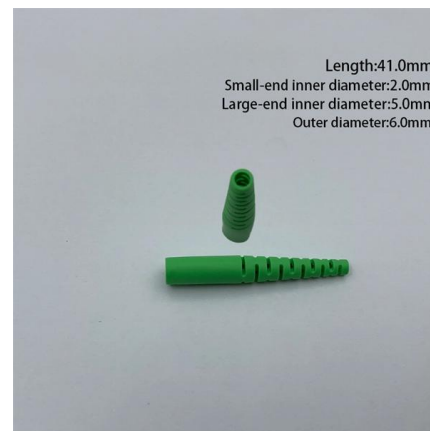
