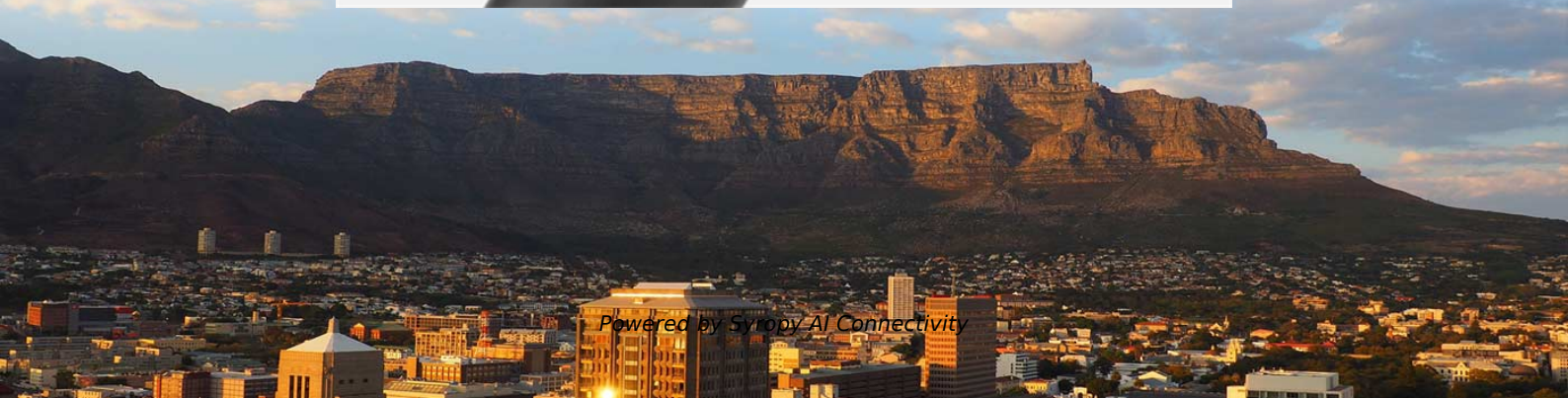
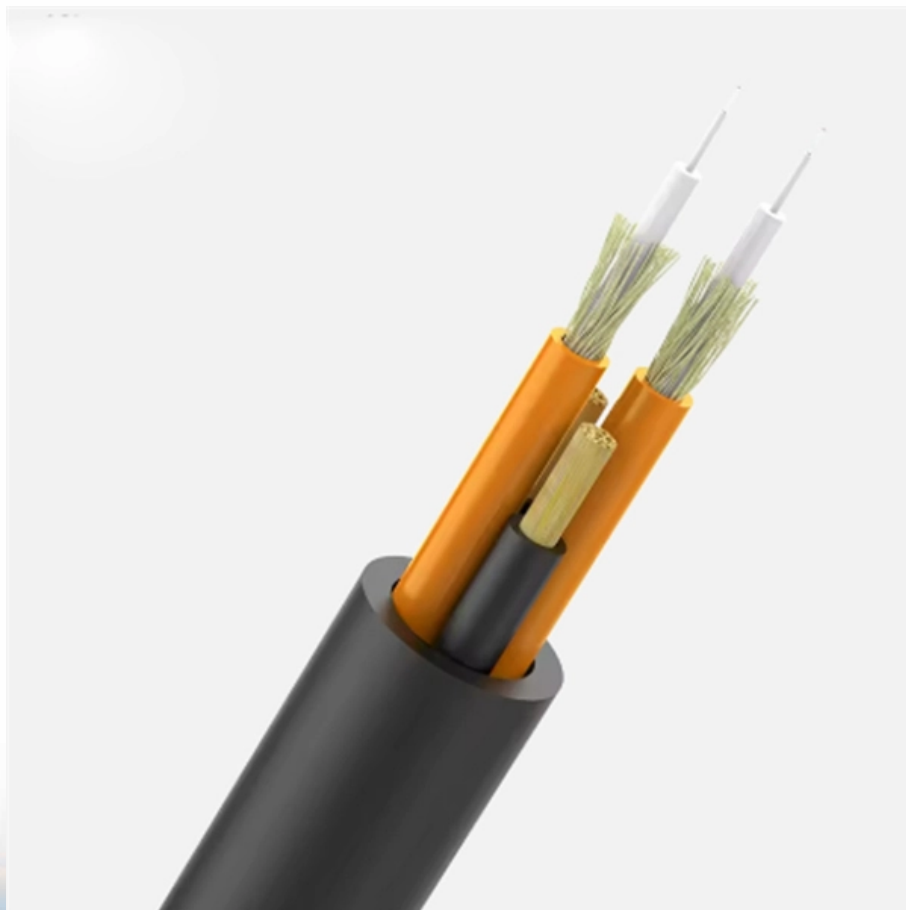


How high should the power cables be installed in an industrial power distribution box





Overview

The installation height of the distribution electrical box should be controlled at 1. At least 1 meter of space should be reserved around the box to facilitate inspection, maintenance, and component replacement. 14 AWG through 1000 kcmil, insulated for operation from 600 volts through 35 kilovolts. Other installations, such as buried and aerial, have different installation parameters. 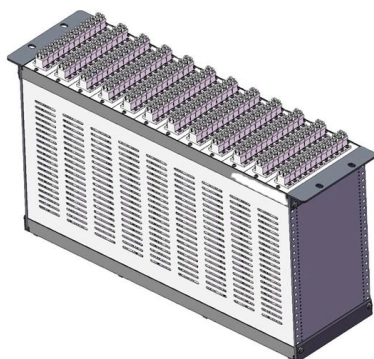
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With higher current loads and distribution circuits there is a trade-off between the cost of larger CSA cables and the losses associated with voltage drop and this will provide constraints for higher current

When single core power cables are installed in parallels in the same cable tray, they shall be of similar nature (e.g. power, cross section, length, etc.). It is recommended to install as few as possible cables

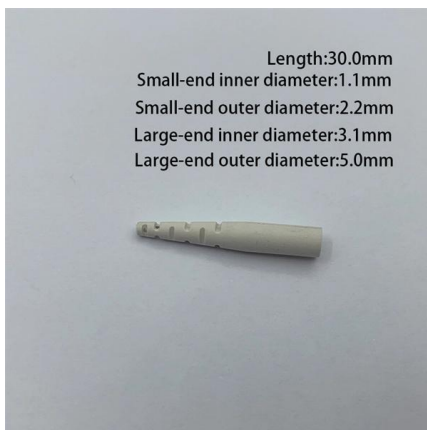

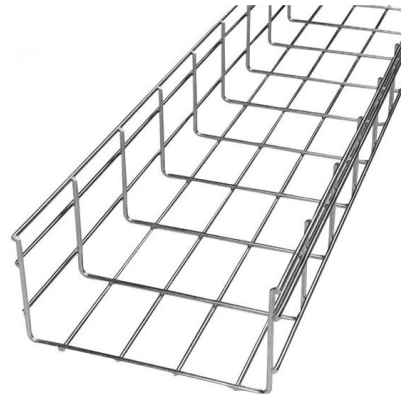

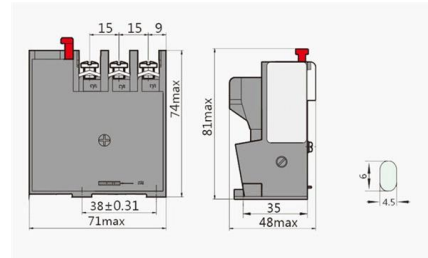
