

How many routers can be connected to a ring network fiber optic cable



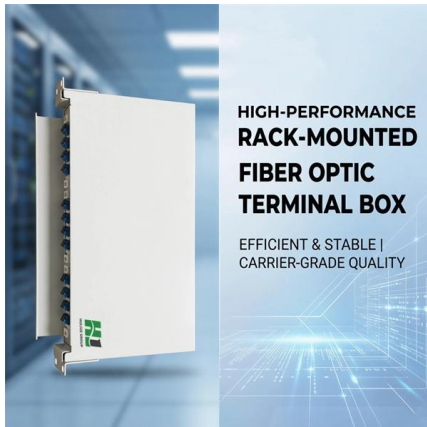


Overview

If the length of the fiber optic cable between TCF-142 devices is 20 km, you can connect up to 5 (five) TCF-142 devices to the network; if the fiber optic cable length is 2 km, up to 50 (fifty) TCF-142 devices can be connected to the network. A fiber optic ring network is a physical or logical network topology where devices (usually switches) are connected in a closed-loop using fiber optic cables. So we sold and implemented 14 Cisco Catalyst 2960S switches and 1 Catalyst 4948E switches. This circular arrangement creates a highly efficient, high-capacity network architecture with several notable advantages. Fiber rings refer to configurations or architectures used in fiber optic networks, often employed in telecommunications to ensure high-speed data transmission with redundancy and reliability. 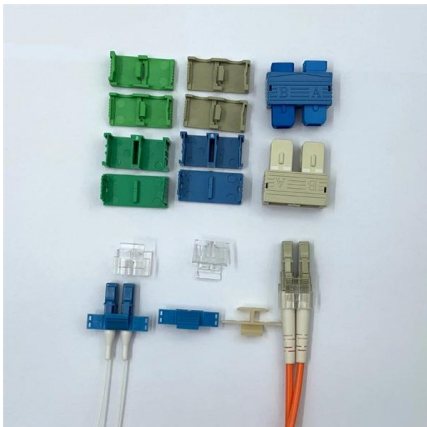

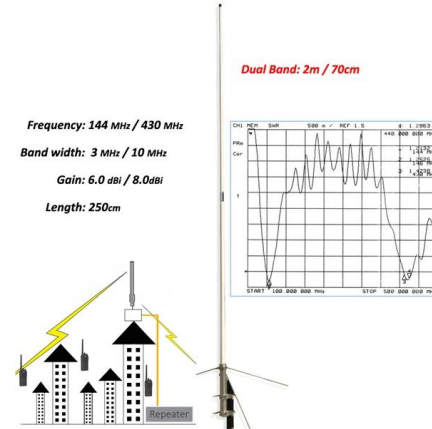
