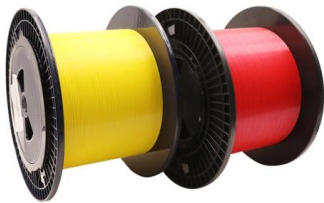

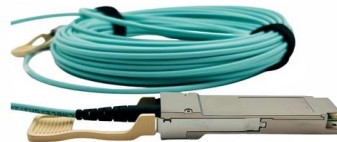

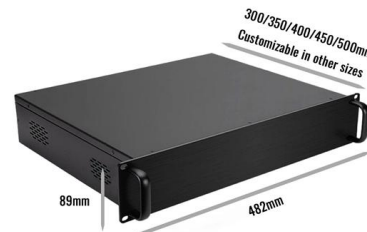

Fiber Count Calculator

This calculator assumes no tolerance, so the actual count in a given bundle may be off a few fibers. In addition, it is very difficult to pack a ferrule with the calculated number of fibers.



Selecting Fiber Type and Count

The number of fiber strands is ultimately determined by installation requirements, including length of cables installed, etc., which ultimately can determine cable
