

Mexican optical receiver QSFP-DD





Overview

This product is a 400Gb/s QSFP-DD optical module designed for 10km optical communication applications. The module converts 8 channels of 50Gb/s (PAM4) electrical input data to 4 channels of CWDM optical signals and multiplexes them into a single channel for 400Gb/s optical. Cisco QSFP-DD and OSFP 800G ZR/ZR+ digital coherent optics modules enable 800G traffic over amplified Dense Wavelength-Division Multiplexing (DWDM) links up to 120 km for 800ZR and over 1000 km for 800G ZR+. QSFP-DD (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable Double Density) represents a transformative advancement in optical transceiver technology, addressing the exponential growth in data center bandwidth requirements and the demands of modern high-performance computing environments. ZR+, Standard Tx output power (-10dBm), C-band tunable, Pull tab, 0°C to 70°C, LC receptacle The emerging OIF 400ZR and Open ZR+ MSA coherent transceivers in QSFP-DD and OSFP form factors generally have low transmit output power (-10 dBm), making them incompatible with ROADM networks. 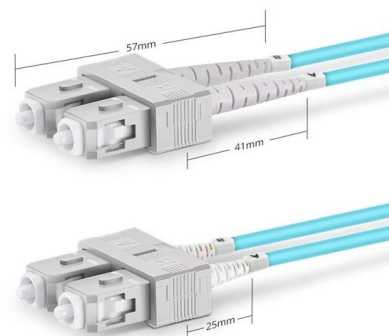

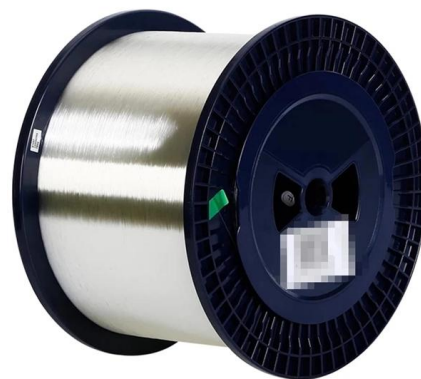
