

National Standard Color for Distribution Boxes





Overview

For three-phase four-wire systems used in distribution boxes, the standard wire colors must be followed: Phase A - Yellow, Phase B - Green, Phase C - Red, Neutral wire - Light Blue, Protective Earth wire - Yellow/Green bi-color. Many countries, including the UK (BS-7671), China, Russia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Ukraine, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Israel, South Africa, Argentina, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia (KSA), and the UAE, have adopted the IEC wiring color codes. The National Electrical Code (NEC) establishes color codes for different types of wiring. 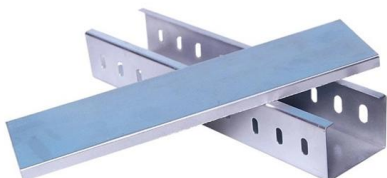

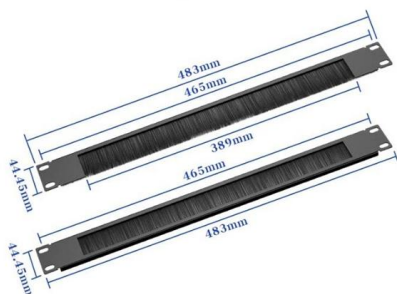

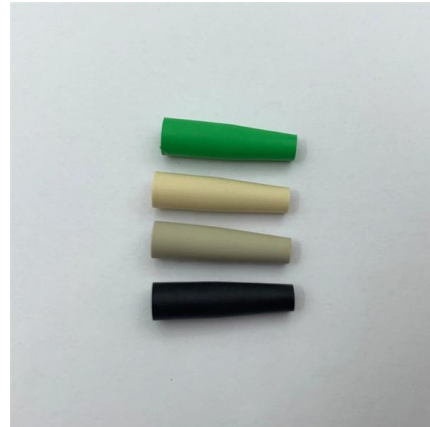
