It is an old style, two wire building where all the plugs had been changed to three holes (without any grounding). The panel is 3 phase because the old HVAC air handler ran on 3 phase



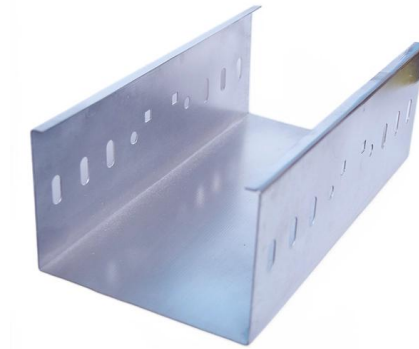

Where to Connect a Ground Wire If No Ground Is Present

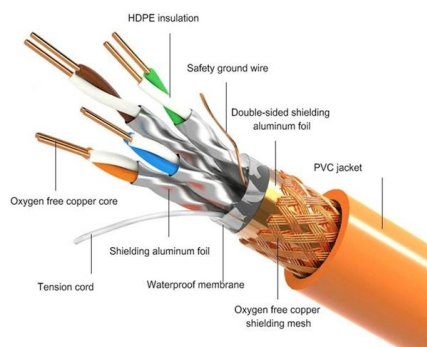

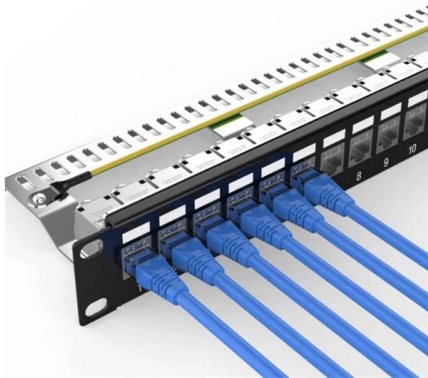

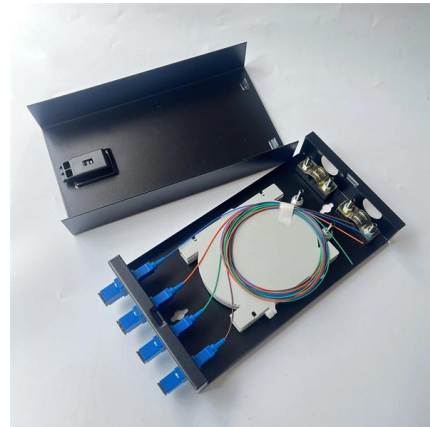
