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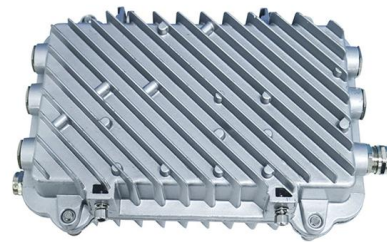


Secondary Distribution Box

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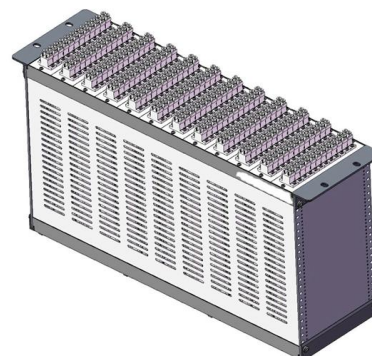

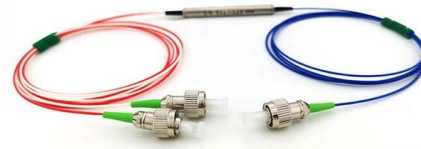

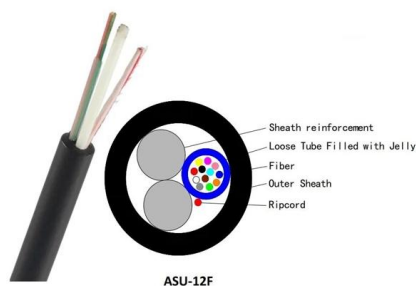


Branch Circuit Design Calculations - Part One
