

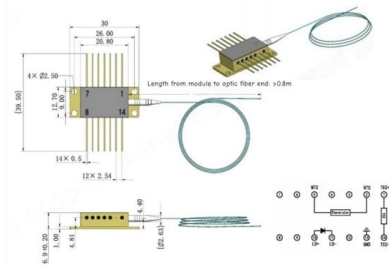

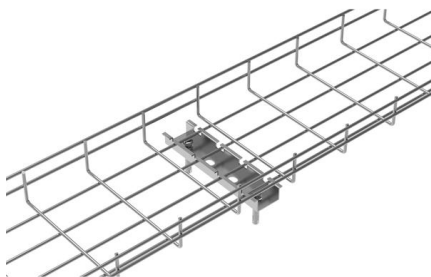

To terminate an optical fiber cable in the field, the fiber (either tight-buffered or loose fan-out tube) is simply stripped, cleaved, inserted into the connector and mechanically secured.

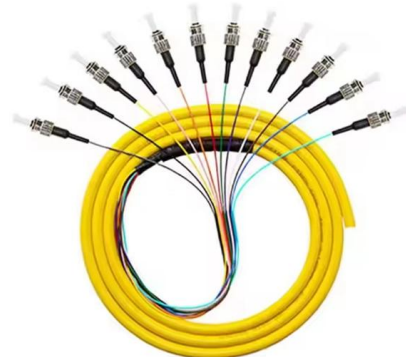

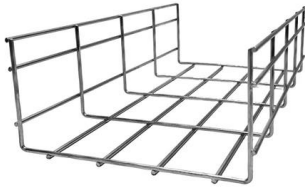
