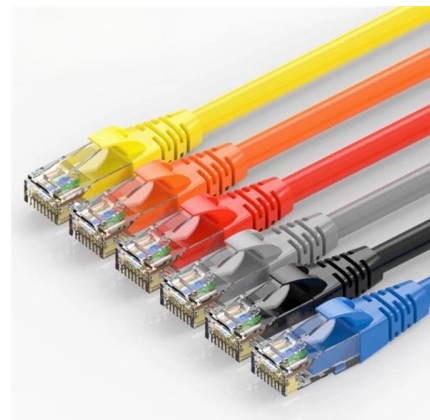


The internal structure of the optical cable split fiber box

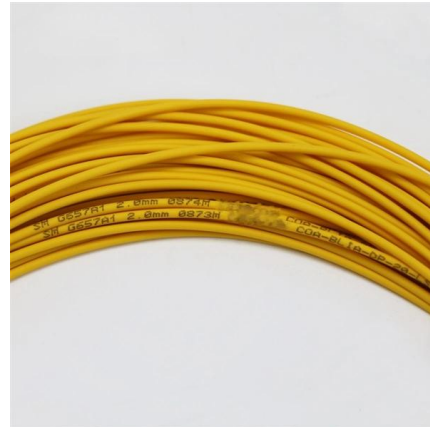
