The function of fiber optic connectors is to align and connect two or more fibers together to provide a means for attaching to, or decoupling from, a transmitter, receiver, or any other fiber optic component. The connectors can be put on patchcords, pigtailed or components with single-mode (SM). It is a precise coupling device that joins fiber optic cables quickly, enabling faster connection and disconnection than splicing. Fiber connectors impact efficiency and reliability in high-capacity data transmission.

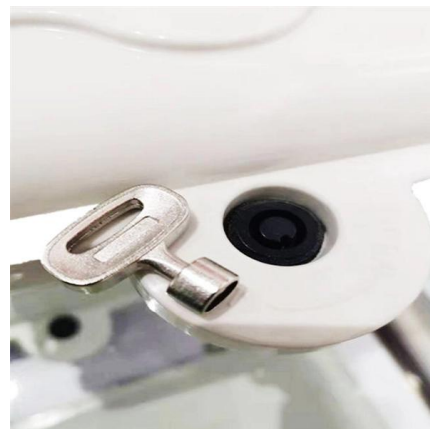

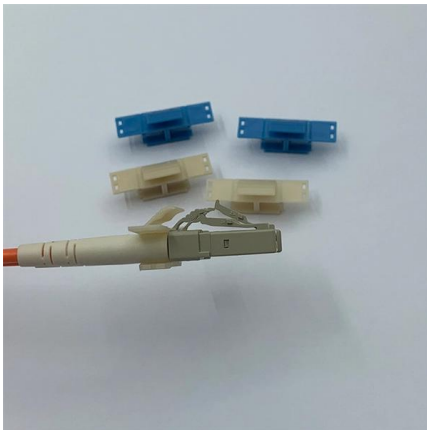

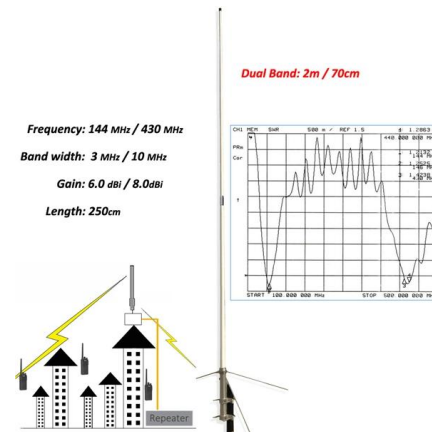
