Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with. * Two (2) sticks of moldable putty (part number FSP-MPS) are also needed for each opening. 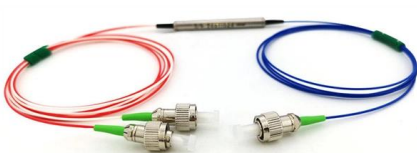

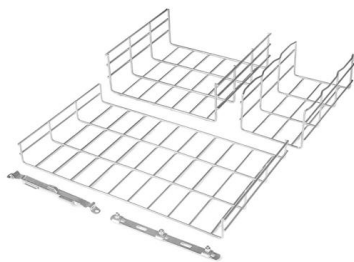

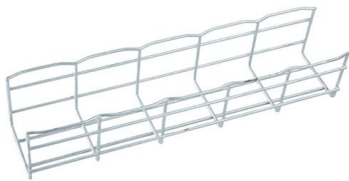
