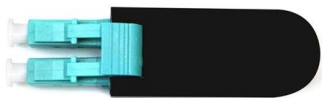

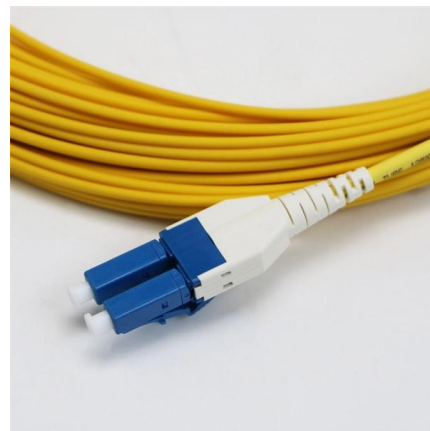


Chart: Where Fiber Broadband is Most Prevalent , Statista

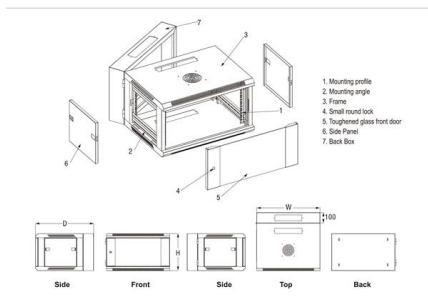
