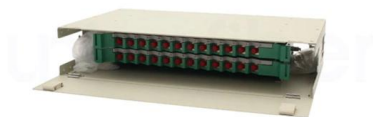

Portfast does two things for us:

- o Interfaces with portfast enabled will go to forwarding mode immediately. The interface will skip the listening and learning state.
- o A



How to Implement PortFast Commands on Cisco

PortFast helps in significantly reducing the time it takes for devices connected to a switch port to start forwarding packets by bypassing the standard

Solved: Portfast on access switches

Notice that because in this case, BPDUFilter was activated on this port in the first place because this port was also a PortFast port, receiving a BPDU will also cause the port to lose its



STP Portfast

PortFast should only be used on ports that connect to end devices, like servers, PCs, or printers. Therefore, the switch only turns on the feature on access ports and automatically disables it on trunk



When should the portfast command be used on Cisco switches

We get a big warning that portfast shouldn't be used on interfaces that connect to other switches, etc. There is also a global command spanning-tree portfast default that will enable portfast



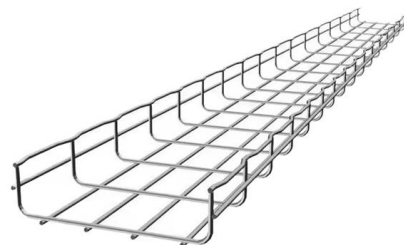
