

What is the spacing between cable tray hangers in meters





Overview

Fixed supports are critical for the overall stability and safety of the cable tray system. When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck. Standard electrical cable tray dimensions for width typically range from 50 millimeters to 1000 millimeters in metric systems, or from 6 inches to 36 inches in imperial measurements. Installation should only be attempted by site personnel well versed in provincial and federal electrical. 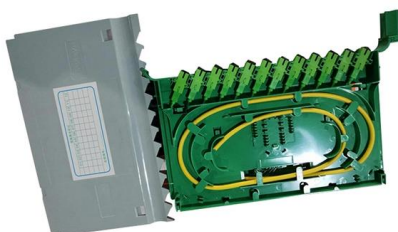

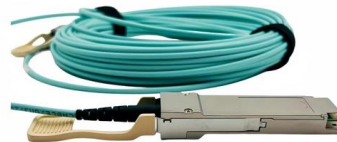
