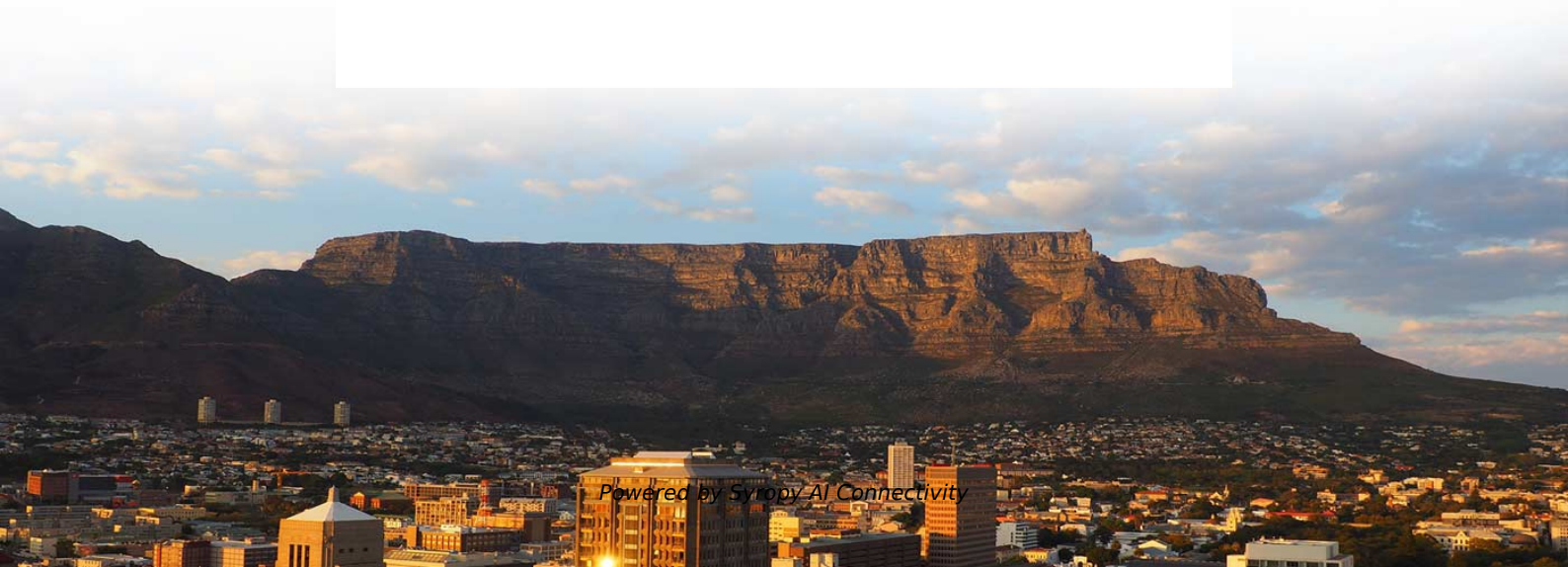


Which fiber optic cable is used for 100Mbps multimode dual-fiber connections





Overview

OM5 fiber, also called Wide Band Multimode Fibre (WB-MMF), is the newest type of multimode fiber cable standard. Multimode Fiber (MMF) has a core diameter, typically 50–100 micrometers, has ability to transfer multiple modes of light through the fiber core, uses lower-cost electronics (LED, VCSEL) operates at the 850 nm and 1300 nm wavelength and is used for short distance interconnections (up to 550m). 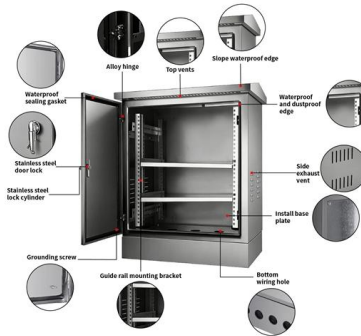

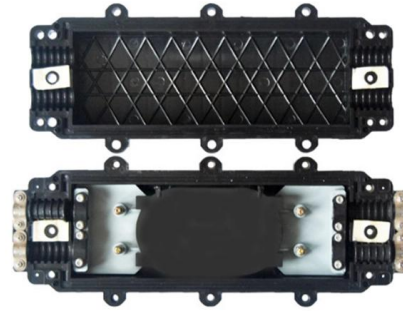
