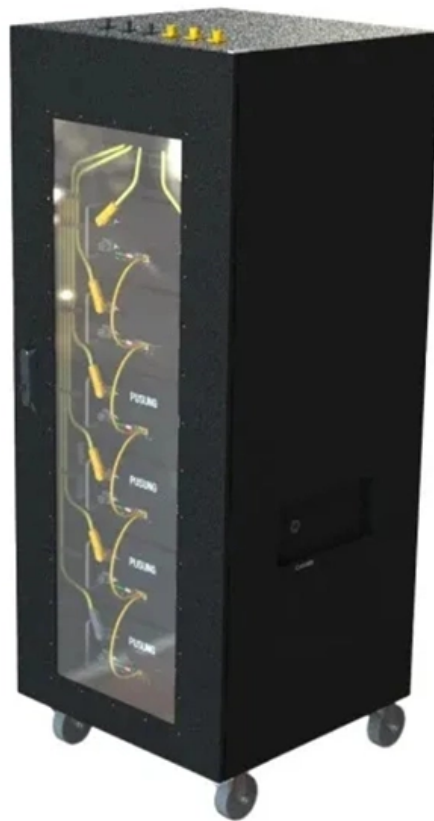


Zimbabwe Fiber Optic Communication Project





Overview

The president of Zimbabwe, Emmerson Mnangagwa, has launched a 1,500km rail fibre optic network project in Somabhula, Gweru. Zimbabwe is advancing its fiber optic infrastructure through a new partnership between PowerTel Communications—a subsidiary of the national electricity company—and Paratus Zimbabwe. The agreement, signed Tuesday, June 17, aims to develop a resilient, high-capacity national backbone network to. GOVERNMENT has, in the past seven years, built an additional 10 152km of long-haul fibre optic backbone across the country, to improve service delivery in critical areas of health, education and agriculture, buttressing the Second Republic's commitment to ensuring that Zimbabwe has superior.
